**Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,**

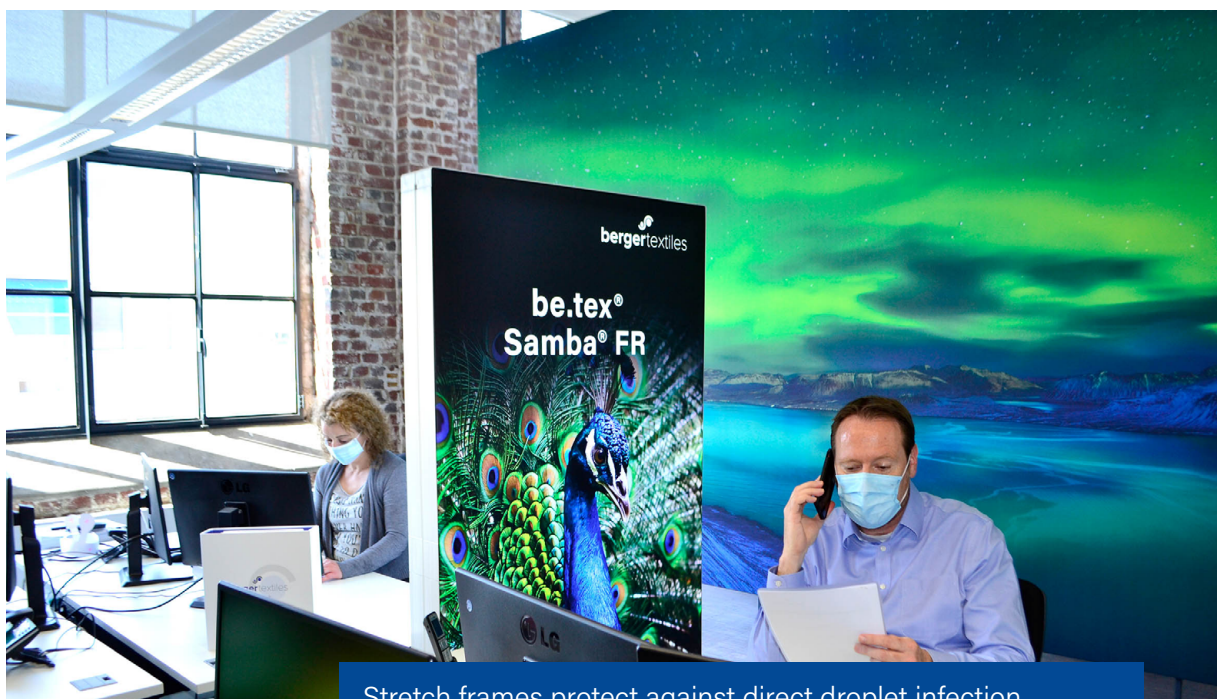
is your company thoroughly prepared for the return of employees to the office?
